

## **Bloomington Ice Center Locker Room Procedures**

A designated number of Locker Rooms will be available to the team/club/individuals renting the ice for an agreed amount of time (typically 45 minutes before and 15 minutes after the scheduled ice slot, times may vary).

It is the team/club/individual's responsibility to ensure that the locker room is clean and undamaged when they arrive and when they exit the locker room. Failure to notify staff of damage or cleanliness upon arrival may result in the team/club/individuals being held responsible for said damage.

Bloomington Ice Center provides security lock boxes for individual use in the locker rooms. It is recommended that individuals lock valuables in these security boxes. Individuals will need to bring their own lock device to secure the box. The lock device must be removed when event is over. All lock devices remaining at the end of the day will be removed and will be cut off if necessary.

### **Locker Room Key Procedures for Practices/Games/Visiting Teams in Bloomington Ice Center**

Locker Room Keys can be signed out if requested at Guest Services. Car keys or a photo ID from an adult 18+ will need to be turned in to secure a locker room key. Car keys will be returned after the locker room has been checked by a Bloomington Ice Center employee. If the locker room is not picked up and left clean, teams will be asked to return to the locker room to pick up trash prior to getting car keys returned.

### **Locker Room Key Procedures for Practices/Games/Visiting Teams in Grossinger Motors Arena**

There are no keys available to teams for locker rooms in the arena. If the team/club/individual would like the room locked during the event, please notify staff to do so. When an adult 18+ signs in at BIC Guest Services, the front staff will verify the locker room is unlocked and locked for team signing in. All other procedures/policies mentioned above regarding damage/repairs, cleaning room before leaving, etc. for the Bloomington Ice Center also apply to the **Grossinger Motors Arena**.

### **Implementation of the USA Hockey Policy for Locker Room Supervision**

**USA Hockey Locker Room Monitoring:** It is the policy of USA Hockey that there be at least one responsible (screened) adult present monitoring the locker room during all team events. As such, each team will assign a Locker Room Monitor during each game, practice, and other applicable team events. **Locker Room Monitors are the responsibility of those clubs that represent USA Hockey.**
